

Ordinance No. 1961-4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST NEWTON, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the fiscal year 1961

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of West Newton, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the said Borough subject to taxation for Borough purposes for the fiscal year 1961, as follows:

Tax rate for general Borough purposes, the sum of Nineteen (19) mills on each dollar of assessed valuation;

Making a total tax rate for all Borough purposes of Nineteen (19) mills.

SECTION 2. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
