

ORDINANCE NO. 1957-2

An Ordinance establishing the center-line grade of High Street in the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania from the South Property Line of Hill Street to the Southerly Borough Line, a distance of 558.00 feet.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and the Town Council of the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that the grade of High Street is hereby established as follows, to wit:

SECTION I. Center-line grade--Beginning at a point on the South Property Line of Hill Street at an elevation of 888.26 feet above mean tide at Sandy Hook; thence ascending on a 1.8738 per cent grade for a distance of 248.00 feet to an elevation of 892.90 feet; thence ascending by a parabolic curve for a distance 20.00 feet to an elevation of 893.24 feet; thence ascending on a 1.5000 per cent grade for a distance of 290.00 feet to an elevation of 897.59 feet on the Southerly Borough Line.

SECTION II. That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same is repealed.
