

ORDINANCE NO. 1958-1

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC UPON THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST NEWTON, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED and enacted by the Council of the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, in council assembled and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. For the purposed of this Ordinance, the words and phrases used herein shall have the same meanings respectively ascribed to them in this Ordinance as are ascribed to them in Section 102 of Article 1 of the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, approved May 1, 1949, P. L. 905.

SECTION 2. Vehicular traffice on Fourth Street from Vine Street to Main Street shall move in a North-bound direction only.

SECTION 3. Parking on Vine Street from the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad Crossing to Water Street, shall be limited to two hours on the Southerly Side of Vine Street.

SECTION 4. Parking in the Borough Parking Lot on Vine Street shall be limited to three hours where so posted.

SECTION 5. Parking on Water Street from the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad Crossing to Cross Street shall be limited to two hours between the hours of 8:00 A. M. and 6:00 P. M.

SECTION 6. Parking shall be prohibited at all times on Allison Street from Monath Street to a point feet East of Monath Street.

SECTION 7. Parking shall be prohibited at all times on the Southerly side of Main Street from Third Street to the Eastern boundary line of the Borough.

SECTION 8. Parking shall be prohibited at all times on the Northerly side of Vine Street from The Baltimore and Ohio Railroad to Water Street.

SECTION 9. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction before the Burgess or any Justice of the Peace, be fined for each and every violation, a sum of not more than Ten (\$10.00) DOLLARS and costs of prosecution, to be collected as like fines or penalties are now, by law, collected and in default of the payment of any of said fines shall be committed to the Westmoreland County jail for a period of not to exceed ten (10) days.

SECTION 10. All Ordinances or sections of Ordinances in conflict with or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
