

## Ordinance No. 1958-11

An Ordinance approving the petition for annexing to the Borough of West Newton, a portion of South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, adjacent to said Borough of West Newton and hereinafter fully described, and providing that the said territory shall be annexed to and become a part of the said Borough if the annexation thereof shall be approved by the court of quarter sessions of said county:

WHEREAS, all of the freeholders of land in a portion of South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, adjacent to said Borough of West Newton, and hereinafter more fully described, have petitioned the Council of the Borough of West Newton requesting the annexation of such territory; and whereas such petition has been accompanied by the fee of one hundred fifth dollare (\$150.00) as required by law; and whereas such petition has attached thereto a certification of the filing of a copy thereof, without the signatures, with the supervisors of said South Huntingdon Township.

NOW, therefore, the Borough of West Newton hereby approves as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of West Newton hereby approves the petition to the said Borough of all the freeholders of the territory proposed to be annexed to the said Borough, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, being that portion of South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, adjacent to said Borough, bounded and descrobed as follows:

ALL THAT CERTAIN tract or parcel of land situate in the Township of South Huntingdon, County of Westmoreland and State of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point in the present Borough line at the Westerly side of Cort Street and adjoining property of the West Newton Water Company; thence along said Borough line as the same now exists, North 57°55' East 966.40 feet to a Boro Monument in Baughman Avenue; thence still along said present Borough line, South 8°41' East 407.50 feet to a Boro Monument; thence still along said present Borough line, South 20°41' East, 275.35 feet to a Boro Monument No. 3; thence still along said present Borough line, North 84°03' East, 93.49 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said present Borough line, South 5°57' East, 351.12 feet to an iron pin; thence South 52°39' West 25.10 feet to a copperweld; thence along property of Malcolm Bailey and wife, North 30°06' West 36.40 feet to a copperweld; thence along property of Malcolm Bailey and wife, North 18°06' West 37.01 feet to a copperweld; thence still along property of Malcolm Bailey and wife, South 52°39' West, 632.92 feet to a copperweld; thence North 48°36' West, 455.61 feet to an old stone monument; thence along property of the West Newton Water Company, North 39°43' 50" West, 239.96 feet to a copperweld, thence still along property of the West Newton Water Company, North 12°17' 30" West, 218.09 feet to a point; thence North 5°57' West, still along the property of the West Newton Water Company, a distance of 120.90 feet to the place of beginning.

Containing an area of 19.4569 acres in accordance with plan of A. M. Stevenson, Engineer, dated June 23, 1958.

If the annexation of the said territory is approved by the court of quarter sessions, the said territory shall be admitted, annexed to and added to the Borough of West Newton as part and parcel of the First Ward of the said Borough, and the same shall, upon compliance with the legal requirements, be subject to the jurisdiction of the authorities of the said Borough of West Newton and shall be entitled to the privileges of the same.

SECTION 2. The proper officials of the Borough of West Newton, as required by law, are hereby authorized and directed to certify to the court of quarter sessions, County of Westmoreland, Pennsylvania, the said petition, as approved hereby, and to file in the said court a certified copy of this ordinance, together with any maps, plots and descriptions required by law to be filed, and to give proper notice of such annexation to the county board of elections of the said county.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
