

ORDINANCE NO. 1958-6

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PAVING OF NORTH FIFTH STREET FROM TULIP ALLEY TO THE NORTHERLY PROPERTY LINE OF LOT NO. 27 IN THE GEORGE PLUMMER PLAN OF LOTS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:

SECTION 1. North Fifth Street from Tulip Alley to the Northerly Property Line of Lot No. 27 in the George Plummer Plan of Lots, a public street in the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, a distance of approximately 1030 feet be paved (Together with the necessary grading and draining) with suitable paying material according to plans and specifications of the Borough Engineer.

SECTION 2. The Borough Engineer is hereby designated as the person in charge of said work with full power to act for the Borough in all things connected with said work.

SECTION 3. Any trees, pipes or other materials interfering with the free and full construction of said work and the making of said improvements are hereby declared to be nuisances and will be removed or changed by or under the direction of the Borough Engineer.

SECTION 4. The costs and expenses of the entire work shall be paid by the Borough of West Newton and the owners of real estate fronting or abutting said street in accordance with the Act of Assembly known as "The Borough Code" as amended, Act of July 10, 1947, P. L. 1621, which Act empowers Boroughs without petition of property owners to improve public streets or parts thereof and to assess a portion of the costs thereof on the owners of the property abutting thereon and provides for the collection of the same.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances or Resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
