

Ordinance No. 1959-1

An Ordinance approving the petition for annexing to the Borough of West Newton, a portion of South Huntingdon, Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, adjacent to said Borough of West Newton and hereinafter fully described, and providing that the said territory shall be annexed to and become a part of the said Borough if the annexation thereof shall be approved by the Court of Quarter Sessions of said county.

WHEREAS, all of the freeholders of land in a portion of South Huntingdon, Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, adjacent to said Borough of West Newton, and hereinafter more fully described, have petitioned the Council of the Borough of West Newton requesting the annexation of such territory; and whereas such petition has been accompanied by the fee of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars as required by law; and whereas such petition has attached thereto a certification of the filing of a copy thereof, without the signatures with the supervisors of said South Huntingdon Township,

NOW, therefore, the Borough of West Newton hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of West Newton hereby approves the petition to the said Borough of all of the freeholders of the territory proposed to be annexed to the said Borough, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, being that portion of South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, adjacent to said Borough, bounded and described as follows:

ALL THAT CERTAIN piece of parcel of land lying and situate in the Township of South Huntingdon, County of Westmoreland and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southwesterly corner of the intersection of High Street and Baughman Avenue and on line dividing South Huntingdon Township and West Newton Borough; thence along the Westerly side of High Street and said dividing line, South 5° 57' East 980 feet to a point; thence South 84° 03' West 70 feet to a point; thence South 5° 57' East 136.99 feet to a point on line of land now or formerly of Anthony Hornicek; thence along line of land of said Hornicek, North 70° 32' East 388.72 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along same, North 66° 33' East 231 feet to a stake on line of land of Lee Painter; thence along line of land of said Lee Painter and Mrs. Gertrude M. Kintigh, North 29° 07' 10" West 495.67 feet to a concrete monument; thence continuing along line of land of said Mrs. Gertrude M. Kintigh, North 6° 42' 50" East 288.75 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along line of land of same and along State Highway Route 71, North 12° 54' 20" West 273.91 feet to a point in said Highway; thence along said Highway, North 49° 22' 40" West 4.64 feet to a point in said Highway; thence through land of Thomas D. Berry et ux., Wilfred B. Everett et ux., across High Street and through land of George F. Stevenson, et ux., South 84° 03' West 460.20 feet to a point; thence through land of said George P. Stevenson et ux. and across Baughman Avenue, South 5° 57' East 56 feet to an iron pin on the Southerly side of said Baughman Avenue; thence along the Southerly side of said Baughman Avenue, North 84° 03' East 100 feet to an iron pin at the place of beginning.

If the annexation of the said territory is approved by the Court of Quarter Sessions, the said territory shall be admitted, annexed to and added to the Borough of West Newton as part and parcel of the First Ward of the said Borough, and the same shall, upon compliance with the legal requirements, be subject to the jurisdiction of the authorities of the said Borough of West Newton and shall be entitled to the privileges of the same.

SECTION 2. The proper officials of the Borough of West Newton, as required by law, are hereby authorized and directed to certify to the Court of Quarter Sessions, County of Westmoreland, Pennsylvania, the said petition, as approved hereby, and to file in the said Court, a certified copy of this ordinance, together with any maps, plots and descriptions required by law to be filed, and to give proper notice of such annexation to the county board of elections of the said county.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
