

ORDINANCE NO. 1959-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST NEWTON, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REQUIRING ALL TRUCKS AND BUSES TO PROCEED IN THE LOWEST GEAR IN SAID VEHICLE WHEN TRAVELING WEST ON MAIN STREET FROM THE EAST LINE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST NEWTON AT THE TOWNSHIP OF SOUTH HUNTINGDON TO THIRD STREET IN SAID BOROUGH AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR FAILURE SO TO DO.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Burgess and Council of the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, in Council Assembled, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that all trucks and buses are required to proceed in the lowest gear in said vehicle when traveling on Main Street from the east line of the Borough of West Newton at South Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, westwardly to Third Street in said Borough.

This regulation is for the protection of Main Street and the safety of traffic thereon.

SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon summary conviction thereof before any Justice of the Peace or Burgess be liable to fine of not more than \$50.00. In the event of non-payment of fines and costs of prosecution, the Justice of the Peace or Burgess may sentence any person convicted of violating this ordinance to undergo imprisonment not exceeding ten (10) days.

SECTION 3. Any ordinance or part of any ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same are, hereby repealed.
