

ORDINANCE NO. 1960-1

An Ordinance establishing the center-line grade of BAUGHMAN AVENUE in the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania from the centerline of Howard Street to the center-line of High Street, a distance of 250.00 feet.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and the Town Council of the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same, that the grade of BAUGHMAN AVENUE is hereby established as follows, to wit:

SECTION I. Center-line grade--Beginning at a point at the center-line intersection of Howard Street at an elevation of 866.97 feet above mean tide at Sandy Hook;

thence ascending on a 4.776 per cent grade for a distance of 12.50 feet to an elevation of 867.57 feet;

thence ascending by a parabolic curve for a distance of 15.00 feet to an elevation of 868.97 feet;

thence ascending on a 13.895 per cent grade for a distance of 202.50 feet to an elevation of 897.11 feet at the West Property line of High Street;

thence ascending by a parabolic curve for a distance of 20.00 feet to the center-line of High Street to an elevation of 899.00 feet.

SECTION II. That any ordinance or part of ordinance conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same is repealed.
