

ORDINANCE NO. 1963-5

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST NEWTON,
WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING
A PORTION OF ALLISON AVENUE, FORMERLY AUBURN STREET.

WHEREAS, the owner of all of the land abutting Allison Avenue, formerly Auburn Street, between the Westerly side of Lincoln Street, formerly Main Street, and the Easterly side of Hickory Alley, has by petition requested the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, to vacate the same and by said petition has released the Borough from any and all damages which may arise by virtue of said vacation, and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, to vacate that portion of Allison Avenue, formerly Auburn Street, as requested in said petition and as herein after described.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is here by ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. That Allison Avenue, formerly Auburn Street, between the Westerly side of Lincoln Street, formerly Main Street, and the Easterly side of Hickory Alley, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the Northwesterly corner of the intersection of Allison Avenue, formerly Auburn Street, and Lincoln Street, formerly Main Street; thence along the Northerly side of Auburn Street, North $69^{\circ} 51'$ West, 332.45 feet to a point at the Northeasterly corner of Allison Avenue, formerly Auburn Street, and Hickory Alley; thence along the Easterly side of Hickory Alley, South $12^{\circ} 16' 50''$ West, 40 feet more or less to the Southeasterly corner of the intersection of Hickory Alley and Allison Avenue, formerly Auburn Street; thence along the Southerly side of Allison Avenue, formerly Auburn Street, South $69^{\circ} 51'$ East, 326.92 feet to a point at the corner of the Southwesterly intersection of Allison Avenue, formerly Auburn Street, and Lincoln Street, formerly Main Street; thence along the Westerly side of Lincoln Street, formerly Main Street, North $20^{\circ} 09'$ East, 40 feet to the place of beginning,

be and the same hereby is vacated.

Section 2. Notice of the passage of this ordinance shall be given, in addition to the advertisement thereof, by the posting of handbills along that portion of Allison Avenue, formerly Auburn Street, vacated by this ordinance within 10 days from the passage of this ordinance. Said notice shall state that the petition for the vacation thereof was signed by all of the owners of the property abutting on the above described portion of Allison Avenue, formerly Auburn Street, and that any person, interested in denying the fact that such petition was so signed, may appeal to the Court of Common Pleas of Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, within 30 days after the passage of this ordinance.
