

ORDINANCE NO. 1963-6

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST NEWTON, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, VACATING PORTIONS OF GRAND AVENUE, BAUGHMAN AVENUE, HARRIS STREET, HOME STREET, BROADWAY, CORT STREET, BIRCH ALLEY, JUNIPER ALLEY, FIR ALLEY, PEACH ALLEY, HOLLY ALLEY, BUCKEYE ALLEY AND ORANGE ALLEY.

WHEREAS, a majority of the owners of all of the land abutting the portions of Grand Avenue, Baughman Avenue, Harris Street, Home Street, Broadway, Cort Street, Birch Alley, Juniper Alley, Fir Alley, Peach Alley, Holly Alley, Buckeye Alley and Orange Alley as hereinafter set forth, have by petition requested the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, to vacate said portions of said streets, avenues and alleys, and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, to vacate the same as requested in said petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. That the following portions of said streets, avenues and alleys hereinafter set forth be and the same are hereby vacated.

1. Grand Avenue, 40 feet in width, extending from the west side of Vine Street through Harris Street, Home Street, Broadway, and Cort Street to property of the West Newton Water Company.
2. Baughman Avenue, 40 feet in width, from a point about 40 feet East of the East line of Harris Street, by Harris Street to the West line of Home Street.
3. Harris Street, 40 feet in width, from the Southerly line of Walnut Alley, through Baughman Avenue and Grand Avenue to the South line extended of Lots Nos. 103 and 119 in the E. Baughman's Southern Extension Plan of Lots, Plan Book Vol. 13, pages 56 and 57.
4. Home Street, 40 feet in width, from a line across the same 50 feet South from the Southerly line of Walnut Alley, through Baughman Avenue, and through Grand Avenue to the Southerly line extended of Lots Nos. 67 and 71 in the E. Baughman's Southern Extension Plan of Lots, Plan Book Vol. 13, pages 56 and 57.
5. Broadway, 50 feet in width, from the Southerly line of Grand Avenue to the South line of Lots Nos. 55 and 39 in the E. Baughman's Southern Extension Plan of Lots, Plan Book Vol. 13, pages 56 and 57.
6. Cort Street, 40 feet in width, from the Southerly line of Grand Avenue to the South line of Lot No. 23 in the E. Baughman's Southern Extension Plan of Lots, Plan Book Vol. 13, pages 56 and 57.
7. Birch Alley, 20 feet in width, from the Southerly line of Walnut Alley to the Southerly line of Buckeye Alley.
8. Juniper Alley, Fir Alley, and Peach Alley, all 12 foot alleys, running from the old Borough line, which is or was situate in the E. Baughman's Southern Extension Plan of Lots, Plan Book Vol. 13, pages 56 and 57. and ran through Lots Nos. 107 to 118 inclusive, at various angles, to 110 feet West of the West line of Home Street, aforesaid.
9. Holly Alley and Buckeye Alley, both 12 foot alleys, running from said aforesaid Borough line through Harris Street to the East side of Home Street.
10. The portion of Juniper Alley running from Cort Street, Eastward to the East line of Lots Nos. 20 and 21, extended in the E. Baughman's Southern Extension Plan of Lots, Plan Book Vol. 13, pages 56 and 57.
11. Orange Alley, 12 feet in width, running from the Southern side of Baughman Avenue to Peach Alley in Plan of Subdivision of E. Baughman, Plan Book Vol. 13, page 54.

Section 2. Notice of the passage of this ordinance shall be given in addition to the advertisement thereof by the posting of handbills along those portions of the above mentioned streets, avenues and alleys vacated by this ordinance within ten (10) days from the passage of this ordinance. Said notice shall state that the petition for vacation thereof was signed by a majority of all of the owners of property abutting upon the portions of said streets, avenues and alleys hereinafter vacated and that any person interested in denying the fact that the petition was so signed may appeal to the Court of Common Pleas of Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, within thirty (30) days after the passage of this ordinance.
