

## ORDINANCE 1971-5

## TAX LEVY AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE.

AN ORDINANCE OF West Newton Borough, Westmoreland County, and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the year 1972 and appropriating specific sums estimated to be required for the specific purposes of the municipal government, hereinafter set forth, during the current year.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of West Newton, County of Westmoreland, Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. That a tax be and the same is hereby levied on all property within the said municipality subject to taxation for the fiscal year 1972 as follows:

Tax rate for general purposes, the sume of-----20 mills.

SECTION 2. That for the expenses for the fiscal year 1972 the following amounts are appropriated from the revenues available for the current year for the specific purpose as set forth, which amounts are more fully itemized in the Budget Form.

SECTION 3. An estimate of the specific items making up the amounts appropriated to the respective Departments is on file in the office of the Borough of West Newton, Pennsylvania.

SECTION 4. That any ordinance, or part of ordinance, conflicting with this ordinance be and the same is hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this ordinance.
