

RESOLUTION NO. 1977 - 1

WHEREAS, the Borough of West Newton supports and encourages the continued use of the Youghiogheny River for recreational purposes, and its protection from noxious influxation; and

WHEREAS, the Wild and Scenic Rivers Task Force has classified the Youghiogheny River as a first priority stream and that such streams should enjoy increased protection from pollution; and

WHEREAS, the Wild and Scenic Rivers Task Force has classified that area of the Youghiogheny River within West Newton's boundaries as suitable for recreational activities; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the Borough of West Newton and the Wild and Scenic Rivers Task Force concerning the Youghiogheny River appear to be the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania as follows:

1. The Borough of West Newton heartily supports the work of the Wild and Scenic Rivers Task Force.
2. The Borough of West Newton shall inform the Wild and Scenic Rivers Task Force of its^o agreement with the task force's aforementioned goals.
3. That all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions not in accord with this Resolution are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.
