
A Resolution of the Borough West Newton authorizing the filing of an application for funds with the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development.



SLUMS AND BLIGHT RESOLUTION

Resolution by the Borough of West Newton

WHEREAS, there are several vacant and dilapidated structures located within the municipality of West Newton Borough.

AND, WHEREAS, such structures constitute a health and safety hazard to our residents.


AND, WHEREAS, such structures identified for demolition will undergo condemnation proceedings outlined within local ordinances when funded and are in compliance with any other requirements of the applicable laws relating to the declaration of the property as a public nuisance and as being in a hazardous or dangerous condition.

AND, WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Community & Economic Development has funds available for the removal of such structures.

AND, WHEREAS, the municipality of West Newton Borough is desirous of obtaining such funds.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, this 11th day of December, 2000, that the municipality of West Newton Borough determines and declares that such structures individually and collectively constitute blighted property in the municipality as defined by the Urban Redevelopment Law (1945, May 24 P.L. 991; 1978, June 23 P.L. 556, No. 94; as amended, 1988, March 30, P.L. 302, No. 39).
