RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF WEST NEWTON BOROUGH SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL NO. 409 ESTABLISHING A GRANT PROGRAM FOR VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY AND VOLUNTEER AMBULANCE SERVICES.

WHEREAS State Senator Sean Logan announced Senate Bill 409 to establish a Grant Program for Volunteer Fire Companies and Volunteer Ambulance Services; and

WHEREAS Senate Bill 409 would provide Volunteer Fire Companies and Volunteer Ambulance Services a grant award each year; and

WHEREAS Senate Bill 409 cites eligible projects as Construction and/or Renovations of Volunteer facilities, repair or purchase of fixtures and furnishings necessary to maintain or improve the capabilities of fire, ambulance and rescue services, repair or purchase of fire fighting, ambulance and rescue equipment, and to reduce debt; and

WHEREAS Senate Bill 409 would provide grants of \$ 15,000 per Volunteer Fire Department every fiscal year; and

WHEREAS Senate Bill 409 would provide grants of \$ 2,500 per Volunteer Ambulance Service every fiscal year.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of West Newton Borough will hereby make application for such a grant on behalf of our Municipality; and


1. The proper Municipal officials are hereby directed to remit to the State Legislature a certified copy of this written Resolution.

If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, legal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of this Resolution. It is hereby declared as the intent of Council that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
