A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST NEWTON, WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE PROPOSAL FOR FUNDS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, Downtown West Newton, Inc. is desirous of obtaining funds from the Department in the amount of \$250,000.00 for acquisition and associated costs of property located at 101-111 North Water Street, West Newton, Pennsylvania.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Downtown West Newton, Inc. will further resolve there are no local share of project costs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Downtown West Newton, Inc. will reimburse the Commonwealth for the State's share of any expenditures found by DCED to be ineligible.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said funds will be deposited in a Downtown West Newton, Inc. account requiring a signature from a designated agent of West Newton Borough.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the West Newton Borough Secretary is directed to execute a certification attesting to the adoptions of this resolution and to furnish a copy of the Resolution to the Department.






