
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A PROPOSAL FOR FUNDS WITH

PENNSYLVANIA


WHEREAS, Borough of West Newton authorizing the filing of funds from the DCED in the amount of \$313,000.00 for the prevention and elimination of blight under Section 4 (c) of the Housing and Redevelopment Assistance Law, as amended.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough of West Newton will assume the provision of the full local share of the project cost, which reflects the \$313,000.00 grant mentioned above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough of West Newton will reimburse the Commonwealth for the DCED's share of any expenditures found by DCED to be ineligible.




