

STATEMENT OF INTENTION

It is the intention of West Newton Borough beginning on January 1, 1986, where possible and where deemed to be in the best interest of West Newton Borough, to continue to have the elected tax collector collect not only those taxes mandated by law to be collected by the elected tax collector, but also those taxes levied under the provisions of The Local Tax Enabling Act with the exception of the Net Profits and Earned Income Tax. West Newton Borough intends to actively solicit proposals from collection agencies to collect the Net Profits and Earned Income Tax at the best rate for West Newton Borough and its taxpayers.

Although the foregoing is a statement of intent of West Newton Borough, it is not intended that this statement of intent shall be legally binding upon West Newton Borough as to the appointment of or compensation payable to the elected tax collector, or for the collection of any tax under The Local Tax Enabling Act. The Borough Council of West Newton Borough reserves its rights under the various provisions of The Local Tax Enabling Act to change this procedure at any time in accordance with law.

This statement of intent shall not apply to collection of the deed transfer tax, where it is the intent of West Newton Borough that a single collector shall collect such tax.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Borough Council of the Borough of West Newton intends to adopt at a Special Meeting to be held on Wednesday, February 13, 1985 at 7:30 P.M. at Council Chambers in the Municipal Building at 112 South Water Street the following proposed ordinance.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST NEWTON PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF AN EARNED INCOME AND NET PROFITS TAX COLLECTOR, PROVIDING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF SUCH COLLECTOR, PROVIDING THE FEES TO BE PAID TO SUCH COLLECTOR, AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR ACTIONS OF COUNCIL TO THE CONTRARY.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Town Council of the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1: The Borough Council of the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, under the authority conferred upon it by the Local Tax Enabling Act (53 P.S. §6910), hereby retains the Southwest Regional Tax Bureau as its earned income and net profits tax collector for the calendar years 1986 and thereafter, at a fee of two (2%) percent of all collections.

SECTION 2: The President of Borough Council and the Borough Secretary are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the Southwest Regional Tax Bureau in accordance with this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: All ordinances, resolutions or motions of Council or any parts of ordinances, resolutions or motions of Council, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed in so far as they are inconsistent herewith.


