The Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) is presently developing plans for the West Newton Bridge located in the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, PA. The West Newton Bridge is a 3-span Parker through truss originally constructed in 1909. The scope of the project is to rehabilitate the bridge to maintain its historic significance while maintaining traffic during construction on a temporary bridge located downstream of the existing bridge. We have enclosed a project location map for your information.
