

Introduction: Lead Safe Westmoreland is a Federally Funded program to help households of low-to-moderate income with young children or a pregnant woman to test for lead by providing a FREE risk assessment and possible lead remediation by a licensed professional if eligible.

Program Requirements

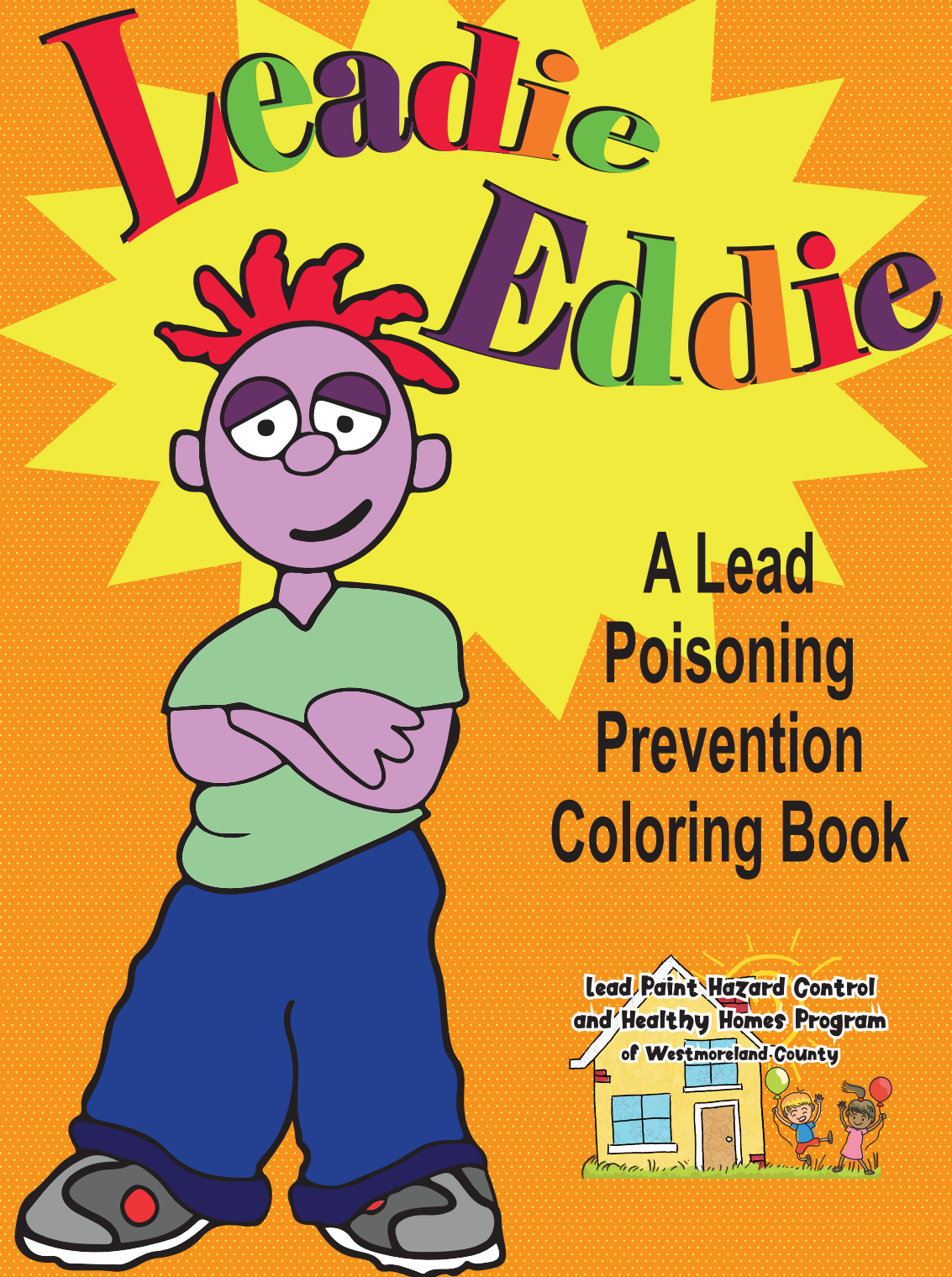
Home was built before 1978 and located in Westmoreland County (rent or own)

A child under six years or a pregnant woman lives in the home or visits regularly (at least 6 hours per week).

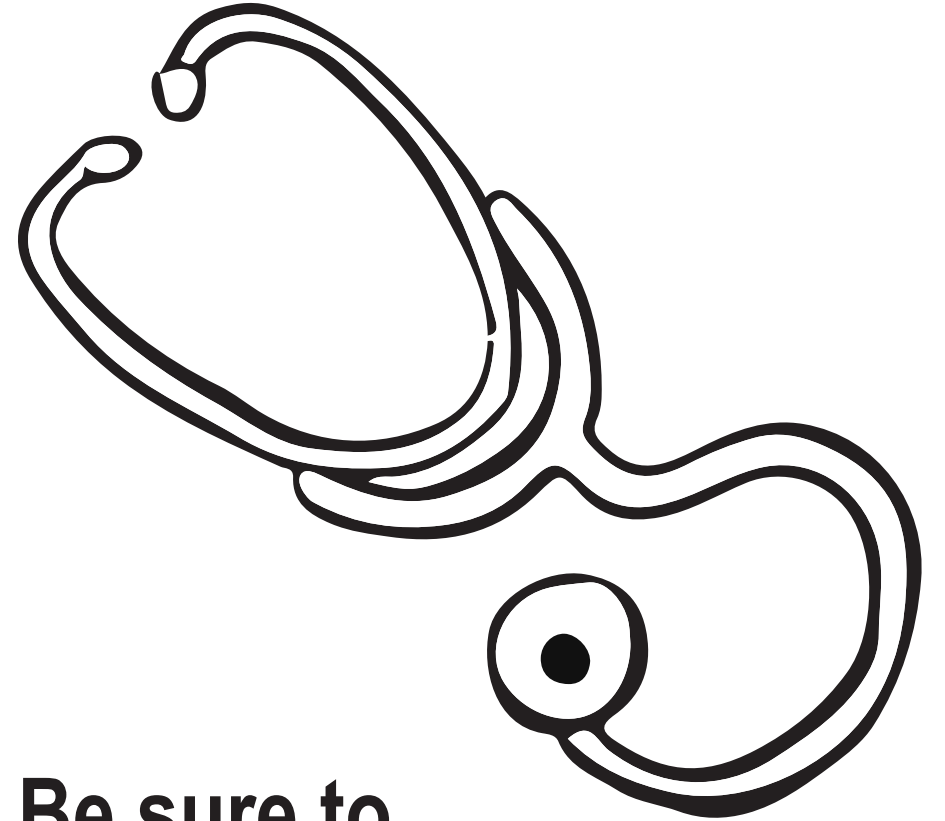
Either be at or below maximum income guidelines according to household size (see chart below).

1 - \$47,500	4 - \$67,850	7 - \$84,150
2 - \$54,300	5 - \$73,300	8 - \$89,600
3 - \$61,100	6 - \$78,750

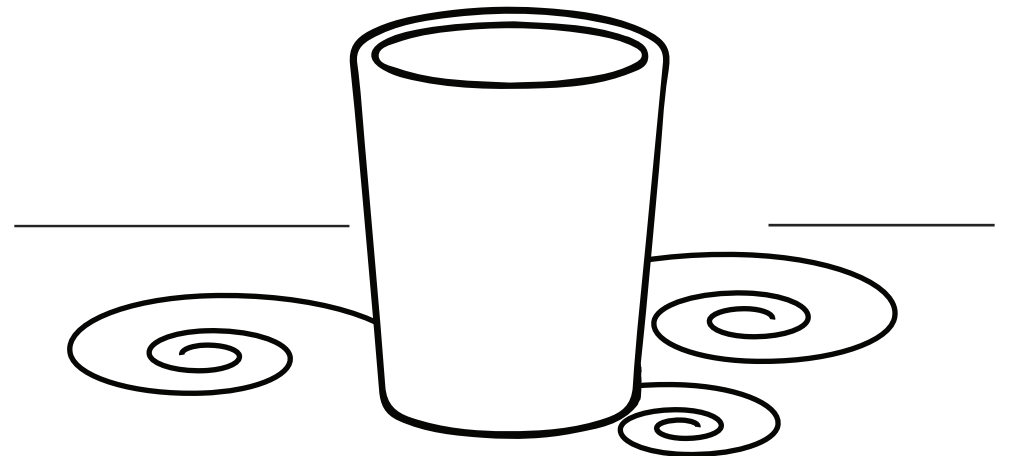




**Eat your vegetables,
