ORDINANCE NO. 2023- 4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST NEWTON, COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2019-4, PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Borough of West Newton is desirous of including further penalties to Ordinance No. 2019-4, concerning service laterals.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby enacted by the Borough Council for the Borough of West Newton, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

Section 1.

Ordinance No. 2019-4, Section IV(A) shall now read as follows:


- A. Violations. Any user who is found to have willfully or negligently failed to comply with any provision of this Ordinance shall be responsible to bring the items in violation into full compliance with this Ordinance, including any costs associated thereto. Failure to do so shall, upon finding of civil liability by a Magisterial District Judge, shall result in a fine not to exceed One Thousand (\$1,000.00). In addition to associated court costs, the Borough may recover reasonable attorneys fees and other expenses related to the violation incurred by the Borough.
- B. Should any violator, upon a finding of civil liability, refuse to come into compliance with any provision of this Ordinance, the Borough is permitted to bring the condition into compliance. The violator shall be responsible for all costs incurred by the Borough. These costs include, but are not limited to, third-party contracting, reasonable attorneys fees, and court costs.




